FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE BULLETIN



The Winchester Marketplace project off of Pleasant Valley Road has been experiencing some problems with trespassing after hours. In an effort to improve site security and to prevent any unwanted injuries that could occur to someone on the property the superintendent has erected a temporary chain-link fence along the end of Spring Street and Greystone Terrace. The fence across Greystone has a gate and the center can easily be lifted out of the concrete base and opened for passage of apparatus. The attached photos show the fencing in the closed and open position at the end of Greystone Terrace and the fence across Spring Street that still allows for access to the existing fire hydrant for that area.

The closest and most likely hydrant option for Greystone is located on the right hand side of the street when you turn off of Millwood Avenue on to Greystone. In the event of an onsite emergency the initial access to the site would be via the construction entrance at the Taco Bell side of the site. There will be no combustible construction materials onsite until all new hydrants have been installed and inspected with the exception of the construction trailer and equipment.
