## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this SOP is to identify employees who are deemed to be at risk for an exposure and identify Designated Officers within the department.

## **EXPOSURE DETERMINATION**

This determination is assigned without the consideration of the use of personal protective equipment. The exposure determination assignments for personnel was made based on if it could be "reasonably anticipated" that an employee would come into contact with blood or other potentially infectious materials. Thus the core of this plan will deal with exposure to blood and other potentially infectious materials (OPIM).

## **Employee groups deemed to be at risk for an exposure**

1. Paramedics
2. EMT's
3. First Responders
4. Social Workers
5. Police
6. Juvenile Detention
7. Life Guards
